## **PROJECT DESCRIPTION**

### **VALLEY VILLAGE PARK STORMWATER CAPTURE PROJECT W.O. NO. EW40085F**

#### **NOTICE TO BIDDERS**

The bid documents for this project will be issued through the City of Los Angeles (CLA) Regional Alliance Marketplace for Procurement ([www.RAMPLA.org](http://www.RAMPLA.org)). Refer to the section entitled "Bid Documents" in this "Project Description" for information on how to obtain these bid documents.

#### **WORK DESCRIPTION**

The project proposes to capture stormwater runoff from a 453-acre tributary area with an estimated average yield up to 136 AFY by flows within the storm drain BI 0463 to the park. Best Management Practices (BMPs) strategically located throughout the park are proposed to capture and store stormwater runoffs. The proposed Project consists of installing a 0.7-acre underground infiltration gallery to capture and infiltrate stormwater at Valley Village Park. Construction of the underground infiltration gallery will include installation of one storm drain diversion structure, storm drain pipes, one hydrodynamic separator (HDS) unit, flow measuring device, and educational signage.

#### **CONTRACTOR'S LICENSE CLASSIFICATION**

At the time of bid the contractor must possess a valid State of California Contractor's License Classification of "A."

#### **PROJECT LABOR AGREEMENT**

This project is subject to the provisions of the Department of Public Works Project Labor Agreement in Part IV of the Bid Proposal.

#### **LOCAL BUSINESS PREFERENCE PROGRAM**

This project is subject to the provisions of the City's Local Business Preference Program. Los Angeles Administrative Code Div 10, Chapter 1, Art 4, Sect 10.25 adopted the LBP Program which was designed to increase local employment and expenditures in the local private sector. All Bidders are eligible to participate in the LBP Program. The City shall grant a 6% bid reduction of their Bid amount solely for Bid evaluation purposes to those bidders who are certified as a Local Business Enterprise (LBE) firm. If the LBE is also a Local Small Business (LSB) and/or Local Transitional Employer (LTE), they may be granted an additional 2% reduction for each of those certifications, up to a total of 10%. The City shall grant a 10% bid reduction of their Bid amount solely for Bid evaluation purposes to those Bidders who are certified as a City Business Enterprise (CBE) firm. If the CBE is also a LSB and/or LTE, they may be granted an additional 2% reduction for each of those certifications, up to a maximum of 12%. Additionally, all non-LBE/CBE Bidders may be granted a 1% bid reduction of their Bid amount solely for Bid evaluation purposes, up to a maximum of 5%, for every 10% of their bid that is to be performed by a LBE, CBE, LSB and/or LTE subcontractor.
